SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2858

As Amended by Senate Committee on
Ways and Means

Brief*

HB 2858, as amended by the Senate Committee on Ways and Means, would change the name of the Fort Hays State University Endowment Association to the Fort Hays State University Foundation. In addition, it would authorize the State Board of Regents, on behalf of the University of Kansas, to sell lots 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, and 12 in block 13 in Lanes' Second Addition (1043 Indiana) to the City of Lawrence in Douglas County. The proceeds from the sale would be deposited in the appropriate restricted fees account of the University of Kansas for operating expenditures.

The bill would take effect upon publication in the statute book.

Background

The Senate Committee on Ways and Means amended the bill to include the provision of SB 638, authorizing the sale of property by the Board of Regents on behalf of the University of Kansas.

A representative of Fort Hays State University spoke in support of the original bill. There were no opponents.

The fiscal note provided by the Division of Budget indicates that the original HB 2858 would have no fiscal effect.
