 Provides relative to the change of address for purposes of voter registration

Removes the authority which permits the registrars of voters to change voter addresses based strictly on the address correction provided by United States Postal Services or its licensee.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION


The agency anticipates a minimal or no effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure. Current law is permissive and does not require that registrars change voters addresses based strictly on the addresses provided by the postal service. Under current procedures, registrars do not change voters addresses based on the addresses provided by the postal service. Instead, registrars are sending an address confirmation card to such voters, which is the same procedure required in the proposed legislation.
