Present Senate Rule provides that proposed instruments are to be filed by 5:00 p.m. on the Friday before the start of the regular session. Proposed Senate Rule provides that joint resolutions proposing constitutional amendments are to be prefiled 10 days before the beginning of a regular session and that bills are to be prefiled no later than 5:00 p.m. on the 10th day prior to a session.

Present Senate Rule provides that no legislative instrument shall be prefiled without the written consent of the author, or of the primary author if there is more than one author.

Proposed Senate Rule retains present Senate Rule, and further provides that requests for proposed instruments must be received by Senate Legislative Services staff no later than 48 hours prior to the prefilings deadline.
