The proposed legislation will require a sheriff to provide information relative to escapes from a jail facility and to provide for notification requirements of those reported escapes.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on state governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.

The proposed legislation would likely increase expenditures by an indeterminable amount for local governmental entities. Proposed law would require the local sheriff's offices to provide escape information to all police departments in the parish and the office of state police.

According to the Louisiana Sheriff's Association, in order to comply with the provisions this bill, each sheriff's office would need to purchase an automated rollover/dialing phone system. The cost for each of the 64 sheriff's office to have an automated phone system is unknown.

The proposed legislation does not specify how notification should occur. If the notification could be done via broadcast e-mail and/or fax, the need for an automated phone system may not be necessary.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
