HOUSING/MANUFACTURED OR INCREASE SG RV See Note Page 1 of 1  
 Provides for changes to the Uniform Standards Code for Manufactured Housing

The proposed legislation provides for changes to the Uniform Standards Code for Manufactured Housing and provides that a person may be restrained by the commission from engaging in any business for which a license has or should be issued under the Code or present law relative to installation of manufactured homes. Provides that all costs incurred by the commission, including reasonable attorney's fees, may be paid by the person or licensee who has been enjoined, or found in violation of the provisions of the Code, or any provision of present law relative to installation of manufactured homes, or any rule or regulation adopted by the commission.

**EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.

**REVENUE EXPLANATION**

The proposed legislation will allow the Louisiana Manufactured Housing Commission to seek reimbursement of costs incurred by the commission in regard to persons found to have violated licensing requirements or installation standards. With no mechanism to recoup these expenses prior to this legislation, the commission has had to absorb these expenses. The potential revenue to the commission regarding this provision is indeterminable and will ultimately depend upon the number of persons or licensees who have been enjoined, or found in violation of these provisions and the total amount of costs incurred by the commission in these matters. This revenue to the commission is anticipated to merely fund any costs which it incurred in preparing for these matters.
