ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH OR NO IMPACT GF EX See Note Page 1 of 1
 Amends the Louisiana Clean Indoor Air Act to prohibit smoking in areas where food is served. (8/15/08)

Proposed law prohibits smoking in any restaurant or bar that serves food at any time while it is open to the public. Present law exempts all bars from this mandate.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure. This bill amends the Smoke-free Air Act (Act 815 of the 2006 Regular Legislative Session) to prohibit smoking in bars that serve food at any time it is open to the public. DHH has indicated that although this measure is not expected to result in any increased expenditures for the agency it is anticipated that a media campaign, similar to the one that was conducted for ACT 815, will be needed to inform the business owners and the public about this new mandate. The media campaign for ACT 815 cost \$1.2 million and was paid for by Louisiana Campaign for Tobacco-Free Living (TFL). DHH anticipates that any costs associated with a media campaign for this measure will also be paid for by TFL or some other non-state entity.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
