CRIME/PUNISHMENT RE INCREASE GF EX See Note Page 1 of 1
 Prohibits use of other electronic communication to entice a minor to engage or participate in sexual conduct. (8/15/08)

Proposed law reduces the age of the victim for purposes of the crime from 18 to 17 and includes as criminal conduct the use of electronic text communication to establish any other form of communication for those purposes.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

Proposed legislation could result in an increase in state general fund expenditures. The exact fiscal impact of the passage of this legislation is indeterminable, as this legislation amends the elements of the crime of computer-aided solicitation of a minor. However, expenditures could increase, based on the FY 08-09 Executive Budget, by \$23.39 per day per offender sentenced to the custody of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections (assuming state inmates are housed at the local level). Currently, there are 18 inmates sentenced to the Department of Public Safety and Corrections for the offense of computer-aided solicitation of a minor.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
