

1.1 A bill for an act

1.2 relating to environment; requiring Pollution Control Agency notification of  
1.3 certain people on the status of underground tanks; proposing coding for new  
1.4 law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 116.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. [116.482] LOCAL NOTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS.

1.7 The agency shall directly notify all state legislators and local officials representing  
1.8 the area where an underground tank is located and all residents and businesses within 1,000  
1.9 feet of the tank within 30 days of receiving any of the following information on a tank:

1.10 (1) the installation of a new underground storage tank system;

1.11 (2) the discovery of an abandoned tank or of a change in the uses, contents, or  
1.12 ownership of a tank under section 116.48, subdivisions 2 and 3;

1.13 (3) reports of all releases under section 115.061, including suspected releases, spills  
1.14 and overfills, and confirmed releases;

1.15 (4) information that is generated in the course of corrective actions taken as defined  
1.16 in section 115C.02, subdivision 4;

1.17 (5) any change in service of the tank; and

1.18 (6) the permanent closure of the tank.
