## RESOLUTION

Amending the Rules of the House of Representatives to observe a moment of silence in the House on the first legislative day of each month for those killed or wounded in United States engagements in Iraq or Afghanistan.

1       *Resolved*, That rule XIV of the Rules of the House  
2 of Representatives is amended by adding at the end the  
3 following new clause:

4       “7. On the first legislative day of each month on  
5 which there is a record vote on any bill or joint resolution,  
6 immediately after that vote, a moment of silence shall be  
7 observed on behalf of those killed or wounded (as well as

- 1 their families) in current United States engagements in
- 2 Iraq or Afghanistan.”.
