2 To adopt House Rule 1.2(J) of the Rules of Order of the House of Representatives, to  
3 prohibit any person from entering into or remaining in the House lobby from the call  
4 to order until the conclusion of the pledge of allegiance.

5 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Legislature of Louisiana  
6 that House Rule 1.2(J) of the Rules of Order of the House of Representatives is hereby  
7 adopted to read as follows:

8 Rule 1.2. Admission to the floor and chamber and House facilities

10 J. No person shall enter or remain in the area designated as the lobby in the  
11 included diagram from the call to order until the conclusion of the pledge of  
12 allegiance.
