HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 25

BY REPRESENTATIVE ST. GERMAIN AND SENATOR DUPRE

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To suspend until sixty days after final adjournment of the 2009 Regular Session of the Legislature Part IV-A of Chapter 4 of Title 34 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, comprised of R.S. 34:852.1 through 852.22, relative to titling of vessels in the state of Louisiana.

WHEREAS, Act No. 319 of the 2007 Regular Session of the Legislature created the Vessel Titling Act and provided that such Act shall become effective statewide on July 1, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries will be titling thousands of new vessels each year; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of the Vessel Titling Act should be suspended in order to give the department and entities working with the department additional time to properly develop and implement an advanced titling system that provides an efficient and effective public service.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana hereby suspends the provisions of Part IV-A of Chapter 4 of Title 34 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, comprised of R.S. 34:852.1 through 852.22.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this suspension shall become effective upon adoption of this Resolution and shall extend through the sixtieth day after final adjournment of the 2009 Regular Session of the Legislature.
