APPROPRIATIONS/JUDGMENT: Payment of judgment against the Department of Transportation and Development in "Paul Long v. State of Louisiana, through the Department of Transportation and Development"

1 AN ACT

2 To appropriate funds out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2008-
3 2009 to be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "Paul Long v. State
4 of Louisiana, through the Department of Transportation and Development"; and to
5 provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. The sum of Sixty-Five Thousand and No/100 (\$65,000.00) Dollars is
8 hereby appropriated out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2008-
9 2009 to be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "Paul Long v. State of
10 Louisiana, through the Department of Transportation and Development", bearing Number
11 2002-10241 on the docket of the Civil District Court for the parish of Orleans, state of
12 Louisiana.

13 Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2008; if vetoed by the governor
14 and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1,
15 2008, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
