 Constitutional amendment to require a two-thirds vote of the elected members of the legislature to enact exceptions to the Code of Governmental Ethics. (2/3-CA13s1(A))
 Proposed constitutional amendment to require approval by 2/3 of the elected members of each house of the legislature to enact an exception to any provision of the Code of Governmental Ethics.
 Provides for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held November 4, 2008.
 Effective December 1 2008.
