2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EPA AUTHORITY TO ACCEPT DIESEL EMIS-**
4 **SIONS REDUCTION SUPPLEMENTAL ENVI-**
5 **RONMENTAL PROJECTS.**

6 The Administrator of the Environmental Protection
7 Agency (hereinafter, the “Agency”) may accept (notwith-
8 standing sections 3302 and 1301 of title 31, United States
9 Code) diesel emissions reduction Supplemental Environ-
10 mental Projects if the projects, as part of a settlement
11 of any alleged violations of environmental law—

- 12 (1) protect human health or the environment;
- 13 (2) are related to the underlying alleged viola-
- 14 tions;
- 15 (3) do not constitute activities that the defend-
- 16 ant would otherwise be legally required to perform;
- 17 and
- 18 (4) do not provide funds for the staff of the
- 19 Agency or for contractors to carry out the Agency’s
- 20 internal operations.
