HOUSE BILL NO. 38

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 47:1923(D), relative to tax assessors; to provide for the payment
3 of certain insurance premiums for certain retired assessors and assessors' employees;
4 and to provide for related matters.

5 Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published
6 as provided by Article III, Section 13 of the Constitution of
7 Louisiana.

8 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

9 Section 1. R.S. 47:1923(D) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

10 §1923. Authority for assessors separately or jointly to contract for insurance;
11 payment of premiums

12 * * *

13 D. In the parishes of Acadia, Allen, Ascension, Assumption, Avoyelles,
14 Beauregard, Bienville, Calcasieu, Claiborne, Concordia, DeSoto, East Baton Rouge,
15 Franklin, Iberia, Iberville, Jackson, Jefferson, Lafayette, Lafourche, LaSalle,
16 Madison, Morehouse, Natchitoches, Orleans, Ouachita, Plaquemines, Pointe Coupee,
17 Rapides, Red River, Sabine, St. Bernard, St. Charles, St. Helena, St. John the Baptist,
18 St. Landry, St. Martin, Tangipahoa, Tensas, Terrebonne, Union, Vermilion, Vernon,
19 Washington, Webster, West Baton Rouge, West Carroll, and West Feliciana, the
20 assessor shall pay the premium cost of group life, dental, group health, hospital,
21 surgical, or other medical insurance for any assessor or assessor's employee who
22 retires with at least twenty years of service who is at least fifty-five years of age or
23 who retires with at least thirty years of service at any age. A uniform policy with

1 respect to the payment of such premium shall be formulated and applied by the
2 assessor of each parish listed in this Subsection.
