# ACT No. 302

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 32:414.2(A)(2)(a) and (b), relative to commercial motor vehicle  
3 drivers disqualification; to provide a definition of felony; and to provide for related  
4 matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 32:414.2(A)(2)(a) and (b) are hereby amended and reenacted to read  
7 as follows:

8 §414.2. Commercial motor vehicle drivers; disqualification; issuance of Class "D"  
9 or "E" license; alcohol content in breath and blood; implied consent

12 (2) Any person shall be disqualified for life from operating a commercial  
13 motor vehicle for:

14 (a) Use of a commercial motor vehicle or noncommercial motor vehicle by  
15 a commercial driver's license holder in the commission of a felony involving the  
16 manufacture, distribution, or dispensing of a controlled substance or possession with  
17 intent to manufacture, distribute, or dispense a controlled substance, and the  
18 commercial driver's license holder shall not be eligible for the ten-year reinstatement.  
19 For purposes of this Subparagraph, "felony" shall be defined as an offense under  
20 state or federal law that is punishable by death or imprisonment for a term exceeding  
21 one year.

22 (b) Use of a commercial motor vehicle or noncommercial motor vehicle by  
23 a commercial driver's license holder in the commission of more than one felony  
24 arising out of different crime episodes. For purposes of this Subparagraph, "felony"
