A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To urge and request the office of motor vehicles, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, to open a branch office in St. Bernard Parish to issue driver licenses.

WHEREAS, the citizens of St. Bernard Parish are returning to the parish to rebuild their homes following Hurricane Katrina; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of St. Bernard Parish have a great need for essential services such as driver licenses; and

WHEREAS, the office of motor vehicles maintained a branch office, prior to Hurricane Katrina; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of St. Bernard Parish desire to have a branch office of the office of motor vehicles opened in their parish to issue driver licenses;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby urge and request that the office of motor vehicles, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, open a branch office in St. Bernard Parish to issue driver licenses.
