AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 39:461.3(A), (B), and (C), relative to the interim emergency board; to provide for agency notification; to provide for an effective date; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 39:461.3(A), (B), and (C) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§461.3. Fiscal information

A. The board shall submit to the Legislative Fiscal Office and the ~~Division of Administration, Budget Office~~, a copy of each request that is made to the board within twenty-four hours of receipt of such request to allow sufficient time for a written analysis of each request to be made. Prior to each meeting of the board, the secretary of the board shall submit to each member of the board an agenda with a copy of the analysis prepared by the Legislative Fiscal Office and the ~~Division of Administration, Budget Office~~. No request shall be considered without such analysis having been made available to each board member prior to each meeting.

B. Upon approval of a specific request by the board, a copy of the analysis of that request made by the ~~legislative fiscal office and the Division of Administration budget office~~ **Legislative Fiscal Office and the division of administration** shall be transmitted, together with other documents required herein to each member of the legislature along with the ballot.

1 C. The board may request the ~~D~~ivision of ~~A~~administration or other such
2 public official or agency as the board may determine to make available a report
3 showing the anticipated receipt from all sources of state revenue for the period for
4 which such funds are sought.

6 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
7 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
8 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
9 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
10 effective on the day following such approval.
