AN ACT

To enact R.S. 38:2212.7 and R.S. 39:1496.2 and 1594.3, relative to procurement; to prohibit bids or proposals for public contracts by certain contract consultants; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 38:2212.7 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§2212.7. Limitations on consultants competing for contracts

Any person contracting with an agency for the purposes of developing bidding documents, requests for proposals, or any other type of solicitation related to a specific procurement shall be prohibited from bidding, proposing, or otherwise competing for award of that procurement. Such persons shall further be prohibited from participating as subcontractors related to the award of that procurement.

Section 2. R.S. 39:1496.2 and 1594.3 are hereby enacted to read as follows:

§1496.2. Limitations on consultants competing for contracts

Any person contracting with an agency for the purposes of developing bidding documents, requests for proposals, or any other type of solicitation related to a specific procurement shall be prohibited from bidding, proposing, or otherwise competing for award of that procurement. Such persons shall further be prohibited from participating as subcontractors related to the award of that procurement.

§1594.3. Limitations on consultants competing for contracts

Any person contracting with an agency for the purposes of developing bidding documents, requests for proposals, or any other type of solicitation related to a specific procurement shall be prohibited from bidding, proposing, or otherwise

1            competing for award of that procurement. Such persons shall further be prohibited  
2            from participating as subcontractors related to the award of that procurement.

3            Section 3. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2008; if vetoed by the governor  
4            and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1,  
5            2008, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
