1 AN ACT

2 To enact Chapter 31-A of Title 48 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, to be
3 comprised of R.S. 48:2106, relative to expressway commissions; to provide for
4 membership on certain such commissions; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. Chapter 31-A of Title 48 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950,
7 comprised of R.S. 48:2106, is hereby enacted to read as follows:

8 **CHAPTER 31-A PROVISIONS AFFECTING MORE THAN ONE**

9 **EXPRESSWAY COMMISSION**

10 **§2106. Membership requirements**

11 **A. The board of directors for each expressway commission with**
12 **boundaries and jurisdiction which are coterminous with parishes having a**
13 **population between one hundred eighty-five thousand and one hundred ninety-**
14 **one thousand, according to the latest federal decennial census, shall include one**
15 **director from an adjacent parish having a population between seventy thousand**
16 **and seventy-five thousand and one director from an adjacent parish having a**
17 **population between fifty-three thousand eight hundred and fifty-five thousand,**
18 **according to the latest federal decennial census.**

19 **B. Each director shall take and subscribe to the oath of office required**
20 **for public officials. Each director shall be a voting member of the board and**
21 **shall be considered in determining a quorum. Directors shall serve until their**
22 **successors are appointed and sworn into office. Directors may be removed from**
23 **office for cause by a district court having jurisdiction.**

1 C. Directors shall not receive any salary for the performance of their
2 duties as directors, but may be reimbursed for mileage expenses incurred for
3 attendance at meetings of the commission. The mileage allowance shall be fixed
4 by the commission in an amount not to exceed the mileage allowance authorized
5 under state travel regulations at rates and standards as promulgated by the
6 division of administration subject to the availability of funds.

7 D. The directors shall be subject to the provisions of the Code of
8 Governmental Ethics.
