HOUSE BILL NO. 12

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 33:441.31, relative to municipal courts; to provide that the mayor of the city
3 of Central may appoint a court magistrate to preside over the mayor's court; to
4 provide for the magistrate's duties and salary; to provide an effective date; and to
5 provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 33:441.31 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

8 §441.31. City of Central; mayor's court; appointment of court magistrate; duties;
9 salary

10 The mayor of the city of Central may, from time to time, appoint an attorney
11 who shall be designated as court magistrate and who shall serve at the pleasure of the
12 mayor, to serve in his stead as the presiding official over the mayor's court.
13 Whenever a magistrate is so designated by the mayor to preside over the mayor's
14 court, he shall exercise the powers and authority of the mayor over said court. The
15 magistrate shall receive a salary fixed and paid by the mayor and councilmen of the
16 city of Central.

17 Section 2. The provisions of this Act shall become effective upon signature by the
18 governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become

1 law without signature by the governor, as provided in Article III, Section 18 of the
2 Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the
3 legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.
