1 AN ACT

2 To enact Children's Code Articles 739(E) and 821(F), relative to continued custody
3 hearings; to provide that continued custody hearings may be conducted in any parish
4 within a judicial district when the judicial district is comprised of more than one
5 parish; and to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. Children's Code Articles 739(E) and 821(F) are hereby enacted to read
8 as follows:

9 Art. 739. Continued custody hearing; time limitations

11 E. Notwithstanding any other provisions of this Code to the contrary, and
12 due to the expedited nature of these hearings, in a judicial district comprised of more
13 than one parish, a continued custody hearing may be conducted in any parish in the
14 judicial district.

18 F. Notwithstanding any other provisions of this Code to the contrary, and
