## A BILL

For the relief of Shigeru Yamada.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR SHIGERU**

4 **YAMADA.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsections (a)  
6 and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality  
7 Act, Shigeru Yamada shall be eligible for issuance of an  
8 immigrant visa or for adjustment of status to that of an

1 alien lawfully admitted for permanent residence upon fil-  
2 ing an application for issuance of an immigrant visa under  
3 section 204 of such Act or for adjustment of status to  
4 lawful permanent resident.

5 (b) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—If Shigeru Yamada  
6 enters the United States before the filing deadline speci-  
7 fied in subsection (c), he shall be considered to have en-  
8 tered and remained lawfully and shall, if otherwise eligible,  
9 be eligible for adjustment of status under section 245 of  
10 the Immigration and Nationality Act as of the date of the  
11 enactment of this Act.

12 (c) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF  
13 FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the ap-  
14 plication for issuance of an immigrant visa or the applica-  
15 tion for adjustment of status is filed with appropriate fees  
16 within 2 years after the date of the enactment of this Act.

17 (d) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBER.—  
18 Upon the granting of an immigrant visa or permanent res-  
19 idence to Shigeru Yamada, the Secretary of State shall  
20 instruct the proper officer to reduce by 1, during the cur-  
21 rent or next following fiscal year, the total number of im-  
22 migrant visas that are made available to natives of the  
23 country of the alien's birth under section 203(a) of the  
24 Immigration and Nationality Act or, if applicable, the  
25 total number of immigrant visas that are made available

1 to natives of the country of the alien's birth under section  
2 202(e) of such Act.

3 (e) DENIAL OF PREFERENTIAL IMMIGRATION  
4 TREATMENT FOR CERTAIN RELATIVES.—The natural  
5 parents, brothers, and sisters of Shigeru Yamada shall  
6 not, by virtue of such relationship, be accorded any right,  
7 privilege, or status under the Immigration and Nationality  
8 Act.
